

Traffic Control

April has arrived along with our first full month of Daylight Savings Time. The darker mornings require extra vigilance for school children & joggers. Please maintain your speed at 25mph or less as posted, obey all traffic signs and safely enter and exit the community.

Let me reiterate to each resident the importance of removing all valuables from your vehicle and locking your vehicle. Please remember traffic control personnel are not the police. In an emergency always dial 911 first and then please call traffic control at 863-326-9496. We co-ordinate with law enforcement and often provide additional information or video to them. Do not call gate personnel to dial 911 for you. You are the witness and you can provide answers to the 911 operator's questions and, if needed, update the responding police officer. The PCSO non-emergency number is 863-298-6200.

Remember all residents need to register their vehicles with traffic control. This information provides a database and makes it easier to facilitate getting guests in. It would be unfortunate if guests are turned away because 23 have no record of the host resident living within the community. A number of new homeowners and renters have not registered their vehicles. Please take the time to register your vehicle and yourself with traffic control.

A friendly reminder for all parents is that children under the age of 14 are not allowed, under Florida Law, to operate golf carts. The golf course is off limits to anyone not authorized to be there. That authorization must come from the pro shop staff. When driving golf carts please stay off of private property. Also, golf carts driven at night must have headlights and taillights.
